At the end of the event, Certificates will be sent to the participants whose works have

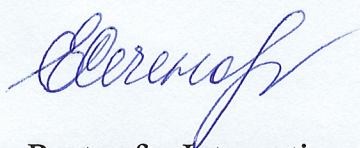
